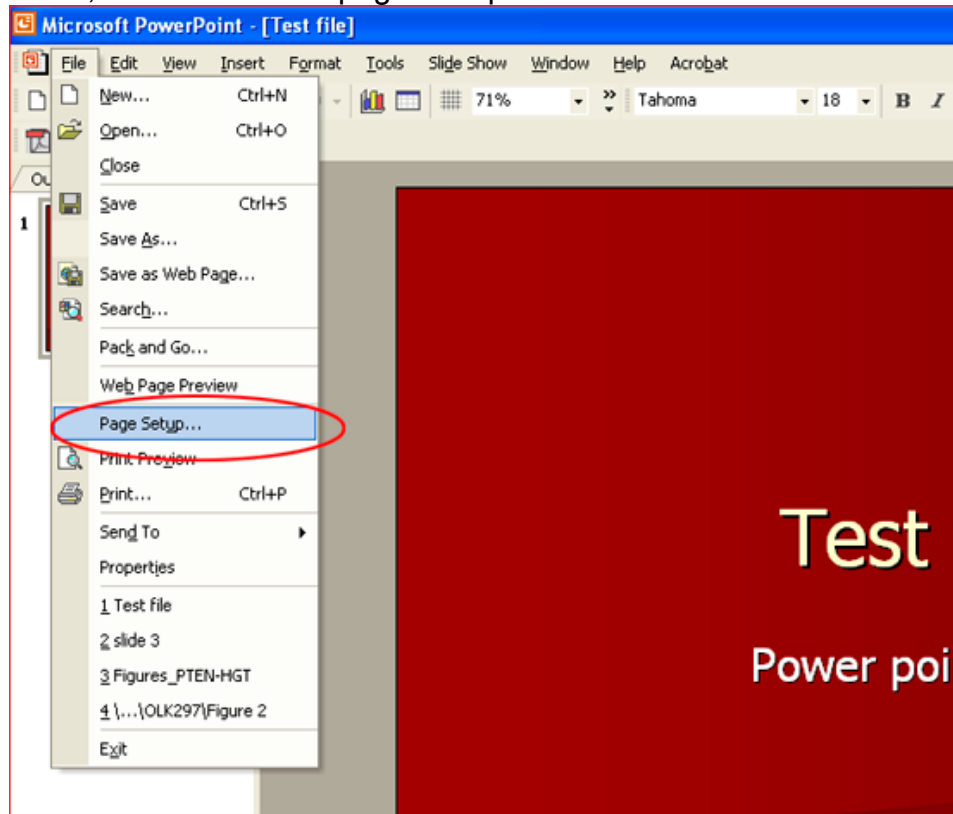
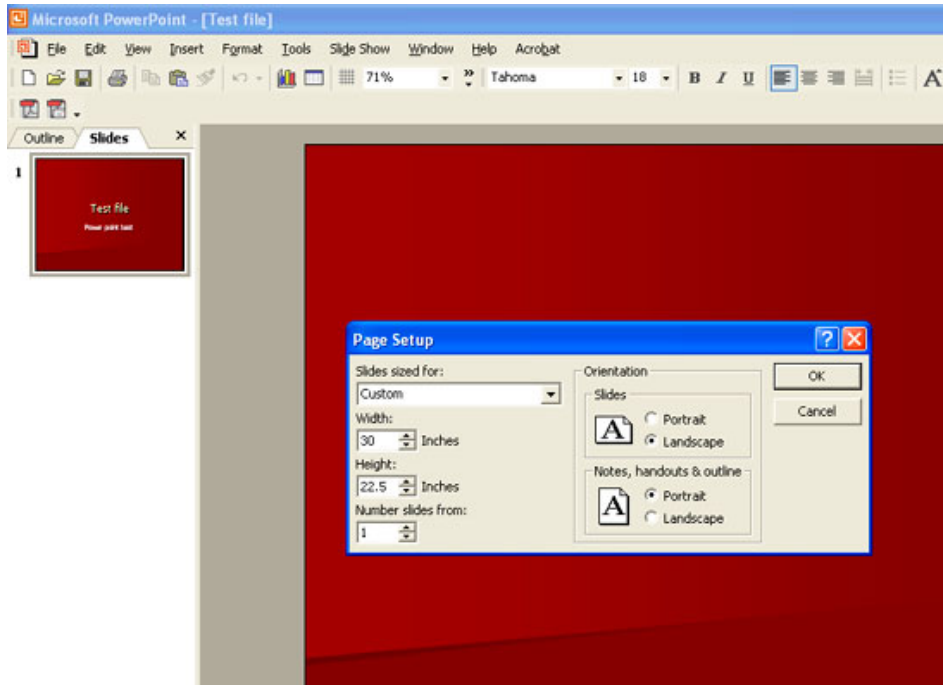


CONVERTING PP TO ADOBE

1. In PP, under “file” find “page set up.”

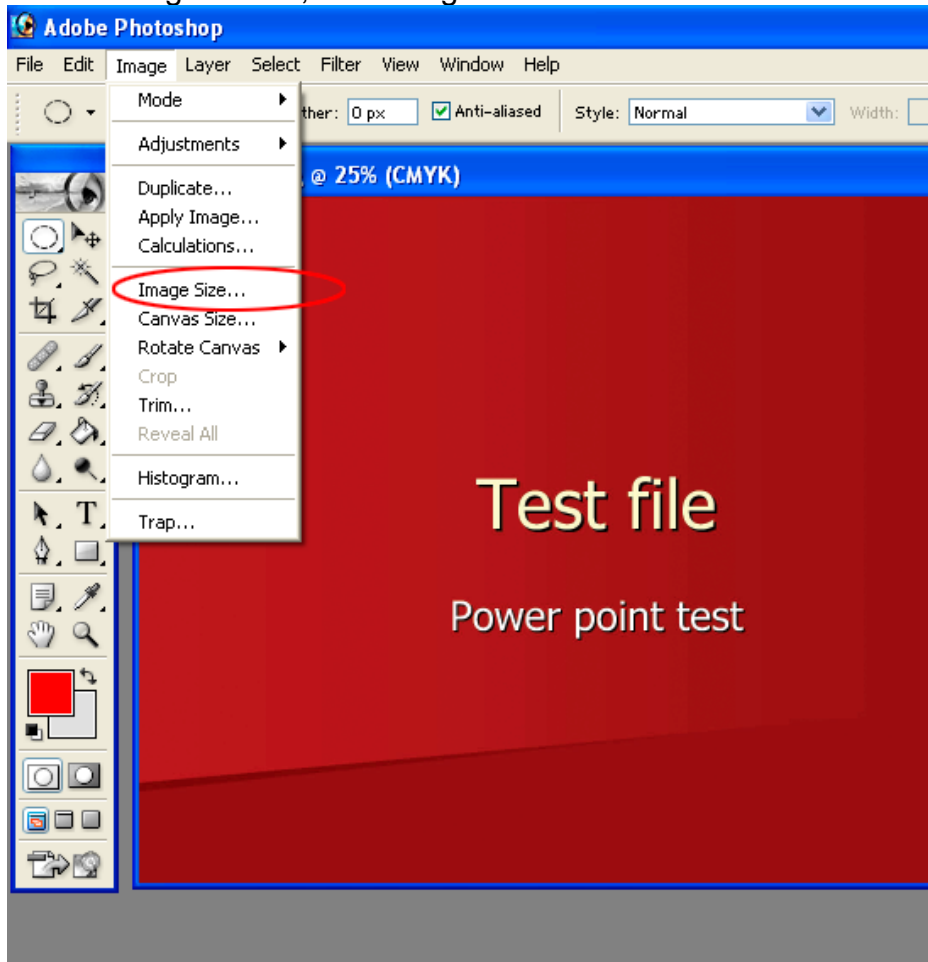


2. Increase size times three.

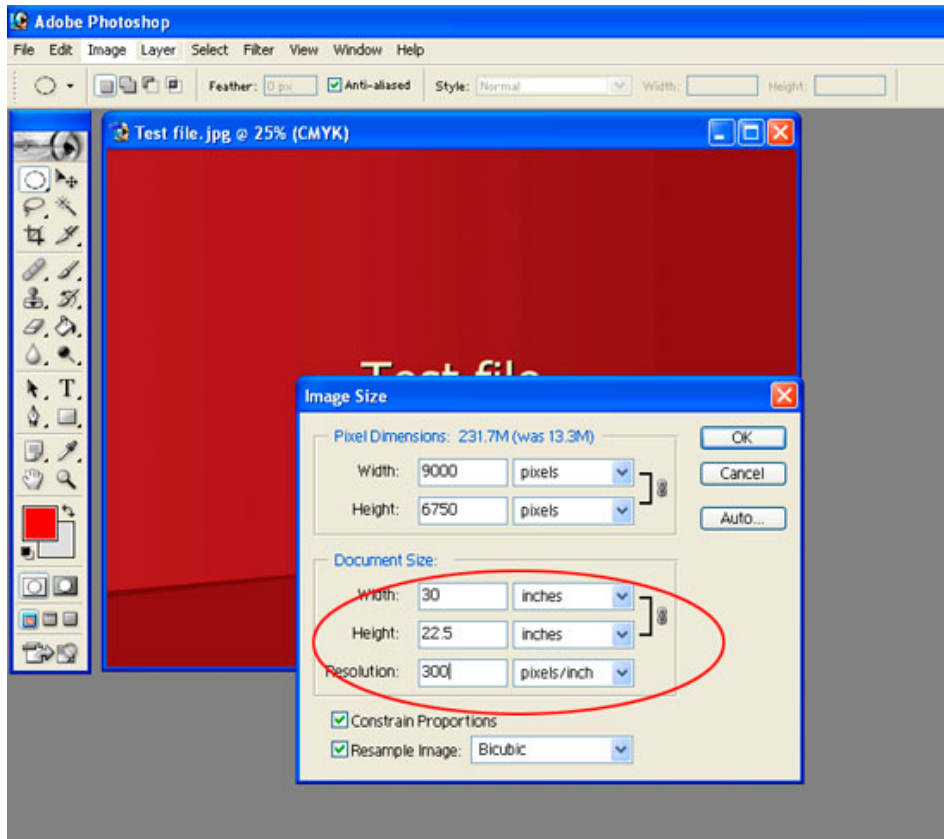


3. While still in Power Point, Save as JPG.
4. Open image in Photoshop.

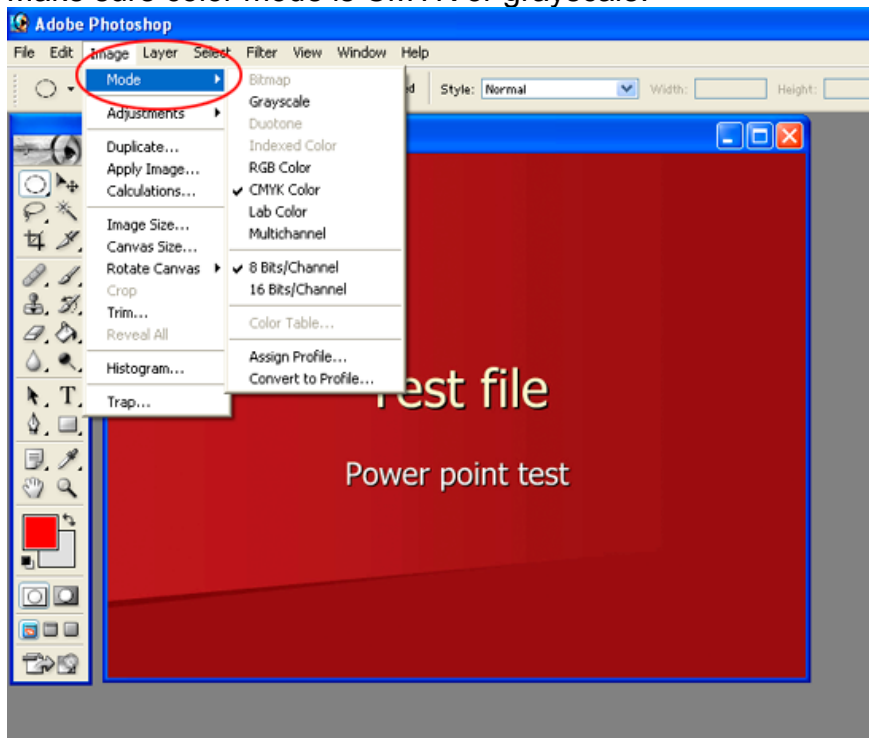
5. Under “image” menu, find “image size”



6. Increase resolution as needed and in same menu, decrease height/width by 3.



7. Make sure color mode is CMYK or grayscale.



8. Save as TIF.
